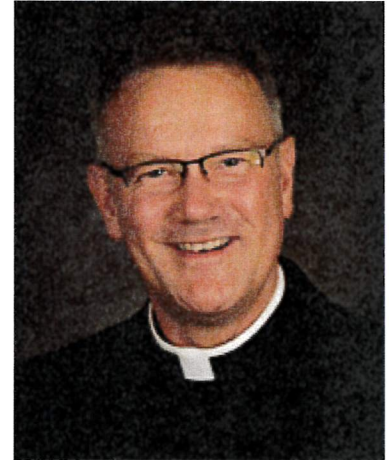

**St. Andrew and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton
Parish Lenten Mission ~ *Living Heroically*
March 10th – 14th**

Rev. John A. Klockeman is a native of the Twin Cities and a priest of the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. He was ordained to the priesthood in May of 2000.

Father Klockeman holds a Masters of Divinity degree from the St. Paul Seminary and a Masters of Theology degree from Franciscan University of Steubenville. Following his ordination, he was assigned to St. Olaf Catholic Church in downtown Minneapolis. In addition to his duties as an associate pastor, he focused on outreach to young adults, catechesis, and wider public outreach on the cable television show, *Generation Cross*. From 2003 to 2009, he served as a spiritual director and formation director for seminarians at St. John Vianney College Seminary. In 2009, he was assigned to the St.



Paul Seminary where he now serves as the assistant director of spiritual formation and teaches at the Archbishop Harry J. Flynn Catechetical Institute.

He has appeared locally and nationally on television and radio programs, has conducted a number of parish missions, and has spoken at various conferences across the United States. Prior to his ordination to the priesthood, Fr. Klockeman worked in medical products field and in the aerospace industry utilizing his Bachelor of Science degree in Marketing and International Business from Arizona State University.

The theme of our parish mission will be *Living Heroically*. In our mission, Fr. Klockeman will unpack the following:

- the spiritual condition in which we find ourselves today;
- how to discern where we are personally bound and lack freedom in Christ;
- and, how to live a life of human excellence and compelling Christian witness, freedom, and transformation in Christ.

Fr. Klockeman will speak at each of the Masses at Seton on March 10th and 11th, inviting us to join him in the church for a morning or evening session Monday through Wednesday, March 12th-14th, either at 9:00am or 7:00pm. Confessions will be heard immediately after each session.
