Flowers for our weekend Masses and Holy Days of Obligation can be donated in memory of, or in honor of a loved one or significant life event. The Memorial Flowers Donor and Intention will be listed in the parish bulletin. During the season of Lent there are no flowers in the church. During the seasons of Christmas and Easter everyone in the parish has the opportunity to donate through a special envelope and all names will be published, as has been our custom, in the Christmas and Easter bulletins. During these two seasons no specific amount is required, allowing each person to donate what they can.

Please fill out the Memorial Flower Form (in narthex or parish office). Seal the payment and form in the Memorial Flower envelope that is attached to the form and place it in the offertory at Mass or bring it to the parish office. **Until the parish office processes your request you are not guaranteed that the date requested will be available.** You will be contacted with a confirmation.

Flower requests must be made at least 2 weeks before the requested date to ensure acknowledgment in the Parish Bulletin.

- 1 small arrangement at the statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary...\$25
- 1 small arrangement at the statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus...\$25
- 2 small arrangements at statue of Mother Seton.... \$25 per arrangement
